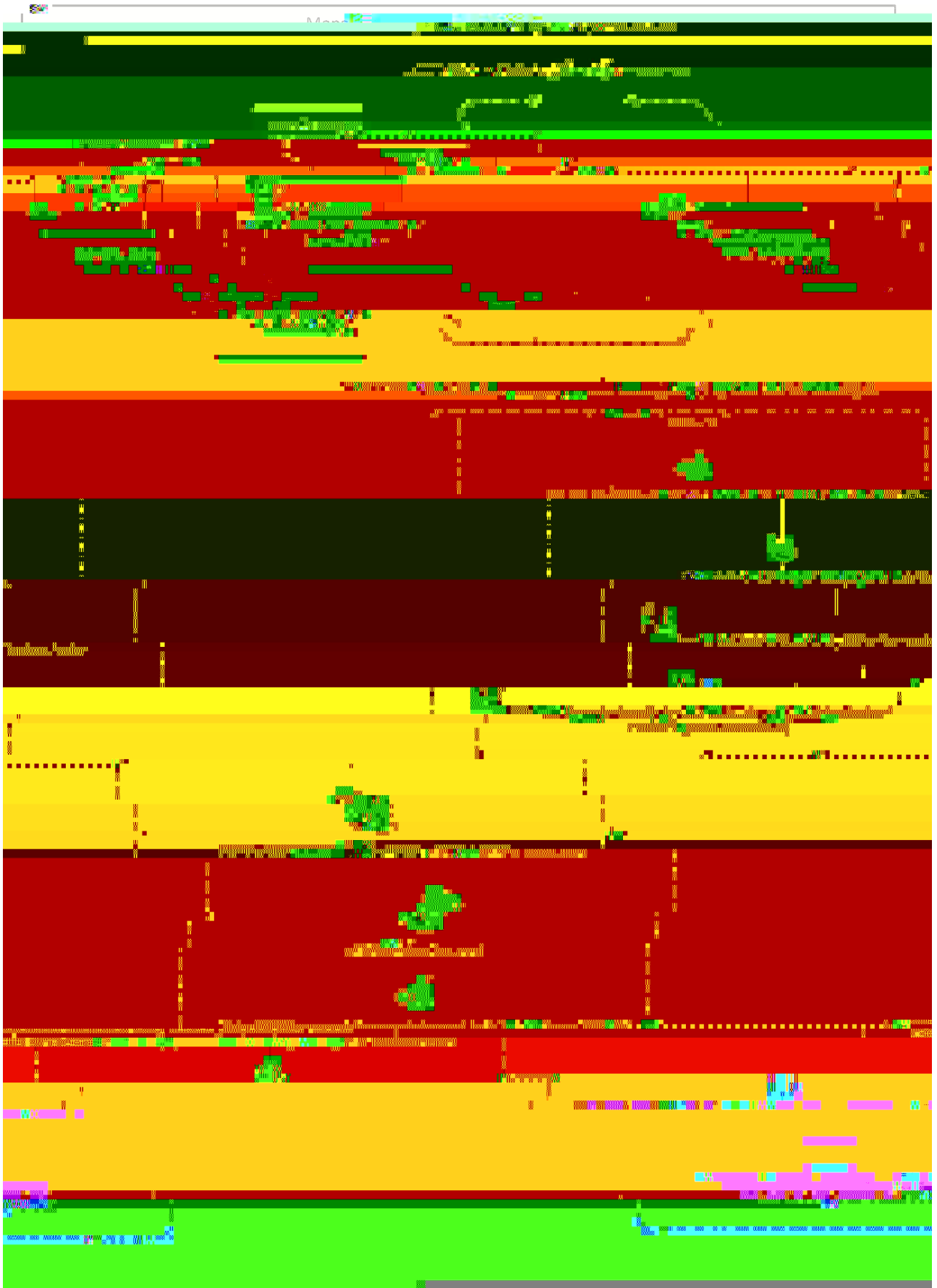


Figure 1 Management of Diving WHS Management Framework and Operations Manual

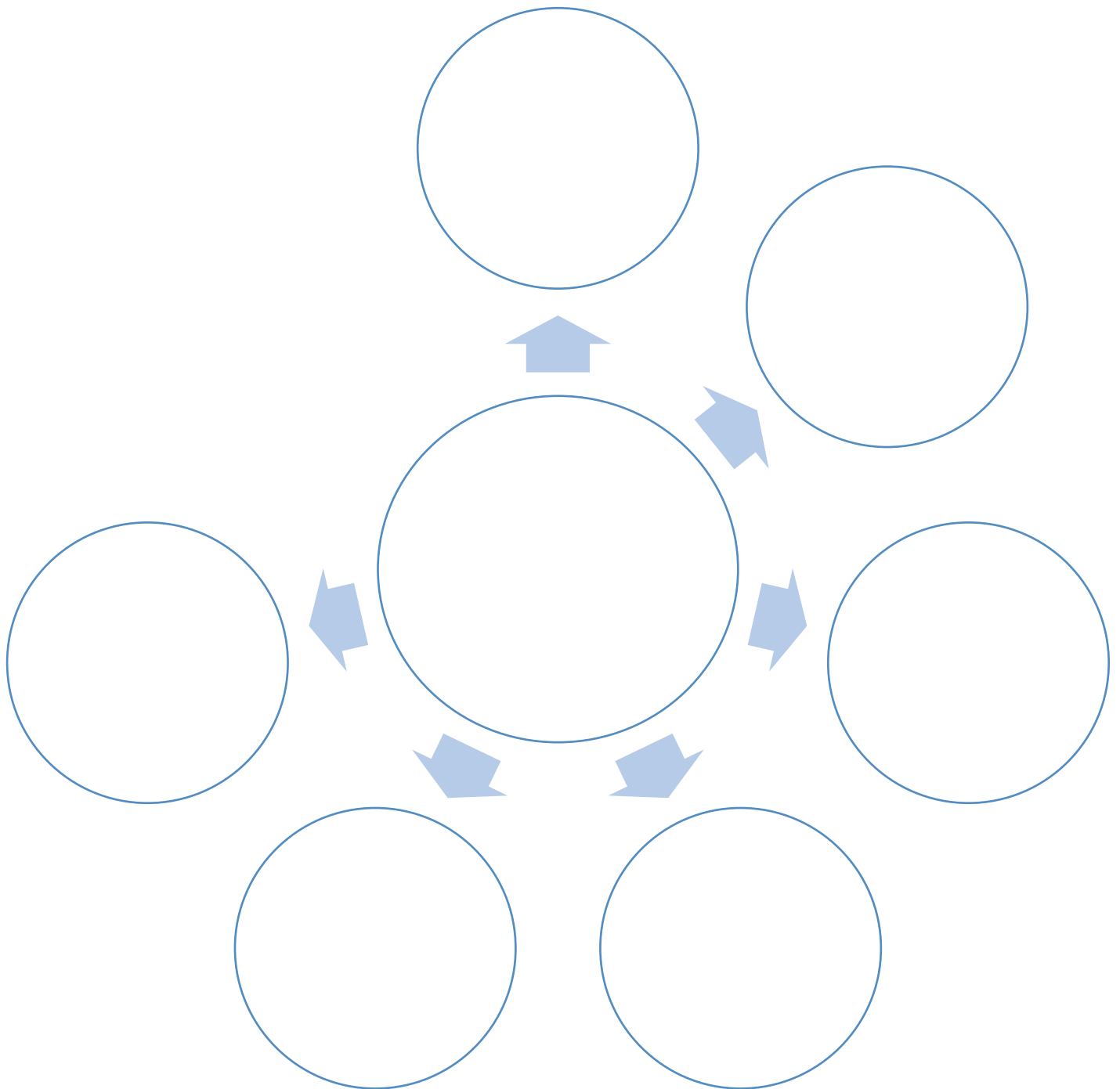


Figure 2 Components of the diving WHS management system

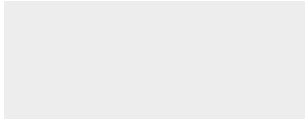
